What is child abuse?

Child abuse is injury of a child by an adult or older child that might not be intentional, but is not accidental. It is usually classified as physical abuse, emotional abuse, or sexual abuse.

Harm caused by withholding life necessities such as food, clothing, shelter, medical care, and education is called neglect.

What if I am not sure that the child is being abused?

The law requires only that you have a reasonable cause to suspect that a child is being abused. Once a report has been made, the appropriate agency will investigate and determine if abuse may be substantiated. The identity of the person making the report is held in confidence.
